**STORM and LIGHTNING**

**In the event of danger from**

## **Lightning Strike**

**The responsibility lies with the individual, but you are advised to:**

- 1. Suspend play immediately when the safety siren is sounded. (See Rules of Golf 6-8)**
- 2. Warn others on the course who may be unaware of the danger.**
- 3. Find a place of safety such as the clubhouse, low clumps of bushes, ditches or low ground.**
- 4. Avoid sheltering under on-course wooden shelters, trees or buggies.**
- 5. Resume play only when it is considered safe to do so.**

**A LONG BLAST FROM A SIREN WILL BE SOUNDED TO SUSPEND PLAY WHEN CONDITIONS ARE CONSIDERED DANGEROUS. TWO SHORT BLASTS FROM A SIREN WILL INDICATE WHEN IT IS SAFE TO RESUME PLAY.**

**These will be sounded from the putting green and 7<sup>th</sup> green**
